VERDICT ON SCHOLASTIC REPORTS

Just for clarity of the verdicts on the scholastic reports, please take note of the following interpretation of verdicts:

- **PROMOTED**
Learner has passed on his/her own merit
- **RETAINED**
Learner has not met the minimum requirements for the grade and will repeat that grade
- **CONDONED/PROGRESSED**
Learner will move to the next grade; however, marks were adjusted by the Department of Education in order to do so.

EXTRA LESSONS

- Being a remedial school - extra lessons plays a very important part
- Learners must make sure they ASK if they do not understand and come to the extra lessons!!!
- All learners are welcome to attend the extra lessons every week. BUT . . . If a learner does not work in class time, does not do assignments and homework they CANNOT expect teachers to accommodate them with an extra lesson.
- NO SPECIFIC DAYS – LEARNERS TO ARRANGE A DAY AND TIME

FORMAL ASSESSMENT

- We follow CAPS (Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement)
- No late handing in of assessments will be tolerated.
- Subject educators will hand out instructions and due dates well in advance
- Due dates for all the assessments are on our website and communicator.



TESTS AND EXAMS

- Exams are written during May/June and November of each year
- Absenteeism due to sickness or urgent unforeseen circumstances must be reported to the Departmental Head. Dr's note must be provided for any absenteeism due to a medical condition.
- Learners who do not write a cycle test or exam, must write on the first Friday he/she is back at school during detention. Failure to do so will result in 0% for the test.
- NO accommodations are available on Fridays.
- Subjects not reflected on the time table will be written during normal class periods. Learners will be notified well in advance by subject educator.

- Please inform the office and register teacher when any information, e.g. personal details, address, tel. no etc. changes. Very important.

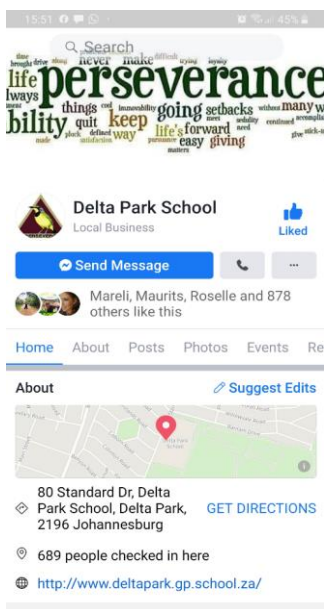
MEDICATION

- Children are not allowed to have any medication with them. Parent must hand it in at the office.

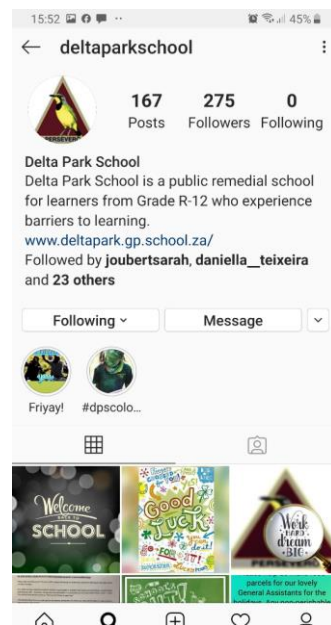
COMMUNICATION

LOCO PARENTIS

- We have experienced a few incidents where learners are being collected very late from school.
- We would therefore like to bring the principle of in loco parentis of the school to your urgent attention.
- In accordance with the South African Schools Act we are permitted to implement the principle of in loco parentis.
- The loco parentis of Delta Park School is half an hour before the start of school each day i.e. from 07h15 and 1 hour after school ends each day i.e. 15h00.
- The same applies to any school event being held outside of normal school hours i.e. half an hour before the start of the event and 1 hour after the completion of the event.

Should a parent not comply with the above loco parentis, the following procedure will be followed:

- **First offence:**
 - Parent will be contacted and a warning will be given.
- **Second offence:**
 - Parents will be contacted and a warning to lay charges of child negligence will be issued. Please take note that this is in accordance with the South African Schools Act, as well as the South African Children's Protection Act.
- **Third offence:**
 - A charge of child negligence, as per the South African Children's Act Form 22, will be laid with the SAPS and the matter will be referred to social welfare.
 - Please view the above seriously. The school cannot accept responsibility for any harm done to any learner outside of the above stipulated times.

MISCONDUCT OF LEARNERS AT PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS FROM SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOLS ACT

SCHEDULE 1 (SERIOUS MISCONDUCT THAT MAY LEAD TO SUSPENSION)

A learner will be guilty of serious misconduct if he or she, intentionally and without just excuse-

- (a) seriously threatens, disrupts or frustrates teaching or learning in a class;
- (b) engages in a conspiracy to disrupt the proper functioning of the school through collective action;
- (c) insults the dignity of or defames any learner or any other person, which includes racist remarks;
- (d) distributes, or is in the possession of any test or examination material that may enable another person to

gain an unfair advantage in a test or examination;

(e) cheats in a test or examination or any other form of assessment such as assignments;

(f) engages in any act of public indecency;

(g) sexually harasses another person;

(h) is found in possession of or distributes pornographic material; or

(i) is under the influence or in the possession of alcohol.

SCHEDULE 2 (SERIOUS MISCONDUCT THAT MAY LEAD TO EXPULSION)

A learner will be guilty of serious misconduct if he or she-

(a) is found guilty of misconduct as contemplated in Schedule 1 after having been found guilty of the same or similar misconduct on two previous occasions;

(b) fails to comply with a punishment of suspension as a correctional measure; or

(c) intentionally and without just excuse-

(i) forges any document or signature to the potential or actual prejudice of the school;

(ii) trades in any test or examination question paper or in any test or examination material;

(iii) attempts to bribe or bribes any person in respect of any test or examination to enable himself or herself or another person to gain an unfair advantage therein;

(iv) engages in fraud;

(v) engages in theft, or otherwise acts dishonestly to the prejudice of another person;

(vi) is in possession, of, consumes or deals in any illegal substance or other harmful substance;

(vii) is in possession of, uses or transmits narcotic or unauthorised drugs or on visible evidence of such possession, use or transmission;

(viii) is in possession of any dangerous weapon;

(ix) assaults or threatens to assault another person;

(x) holds any person hostage;

(xi) murders any person;

(xii) rapes any person, or engages in any sexual activity which amounts to an offence in law; or

(xiii) maliciously damages property.
